His presentation highlighted some of the past sets of school marks and how it equates to an ATAR and stressed that children pick subjects they enjoy and that parents encourage students to do their best.</p> <p>Principal’s report- Mr Humphreys Masters academy- 125 enrolled Last day of school for this year 17th Dec 100 students to sit UMAT HSC trials to begin in coming weeks and children are aware of school ranking and HSC performance of last year.
